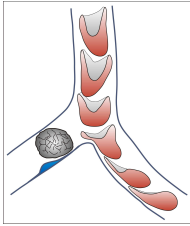

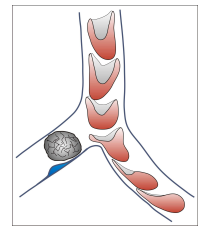


**Hermann-Rein-Award for outstanding achievements

For personal applications, please provide:

- **A peer-reviewed paper (published or accepted for publication, PDF-file) with the applicant being the only or first author** (agreement of co-authors is needed)
- Exceptionally and if justified by contents, 2 joint publications may be submitted
- **Published articles should not be older than 2 years upon application**
- Curriculum vitae, research fields, reference list (**PDF-file**)

In case of proposals which should include author and publication, the application material will be solicited from the candidate by the award committee.
